



Across the entire region Junction supported 309 people experiencing or at risk of homelessness in the 22-23 financial year








FLEURIEU EARLY INTERVENTION PROGRAM

From July 2022 to January 2023 the Early Intervention Program supported 39 people at risk of homelessness






Yankalilla region median rent \$363pw, 1.4% increase in 12mth






FLEURIEU AND KANGAROO ISLAND REGION

Aged population – people aged 70+ much higher than regional SA average. Wait lists for aged care and respite facilities

Youth – lack of emergency accommodation in region, especially for under 18-year-olds

Tourist destination – impact of holiday rentals, less options during peak tourism times

We need increased social and affordable housing – a range of housing options to suit various cohorts
