Management Committee	There is no mention in the constitution of a Board. This has simply evolved. The Board is a Management Committee that makes decisions and takes actions on behalf of members that relate to existing governance matters and grants.	The Management Committee should be nominated and elected at an AGM from the membership base or approved by the Directors between AGMs.	The Management Committee actively manage all existing areas of grants, communication, donor communication and report directly to the Directors. Board of Directors	Effectively this group are the executive of the organisation and should include the Chair & Company Secretary plus additional members to at least meet the minimum number of Directors specified in the constitution.	Constitutionally the Company, i.e. the FCF Ltd can have 12 Directors but must have at least 5 persons willing to act as Directors of the company Directors must be members and regularly attend Board of Management meetings	The Directors have the ultimate responsibility on behalf of the members for good governance, including policies, budgets and any unbudgeted expenditure.	Currently meets as needed but should meet regularly and at least 4 times per annum.
