

YANKALILLA DISTRICT YOUNG ADULT AWARD

GUIDELINES

What is the Purpose of the Award?

The Yankalilla District Young Adult Award has been established as a partnership between the Yankalilla Community and the Fleurieu Community Foundation. The Award aims to provide support to young adults aged 18 to 21 years, who are living in the Yankalilla District Council area or have a close association with the Yankalilla District Council area.

The Award's main purpose is to support young adults who show initiative and commitment in their field of education or training but who may be experiencing difficulty in continuing their studies or accessing other education or training due to hardship or disadvantage.

It is expected that a number of awards will be offered each year for a total amount of up to \$1,000.

About the Fleurieu Community Foundation

The Fleurieu Community Foundation was established in 2010 to help philanthropic individuals and organisations support grass-root initiatives that respond to community needs. It uses charitable giving to meet the current and future needs of local communities. The Foundation currently offers a number of grants and programs across the Fleurieu. Who can apply?

Young Adults

- Aged 18 to 21 years who are attending or enrolled to attend a recognised course of study and training.
- Who are experiencing difficulties in continuing their study or training, or accessing other education or training due to hardship or disadvantage, but have shown initiative, strength and commitment in pursuing their education and training goals
- Live in the Yankalilla District Council Area or have strong associations with the Yankalilla District Council Area.
- Generally this award is available to first time applicants. Although a previous successful applicant may still be considered based on their situation and need.

What can the Award be used for?

The award can be used for:

- The award is available for education and training costs
- Associated living, travel and boarding costs.
- Associated compulsory costs such as uniforms, safety clothing, stationery and equipment required to undertake the field of study and training.

Application Procedure

Applicants must complete the application form and include two signed letters of support from two referees. The referees should have a direct knowledge of the applicant's character, life situation and educational or training goals and aspirations.

Applicants are welcome to discuss their application and are encouraged to do so if they are unsure of their eligibility to apply or need assistance. Successful applicants will be required to sign the Fleurieu Community Foundation funding conditions and provide a brief summary on the use of the funds. Successful applicants will also be required to provide proof of enrolment before receiving the Award.
